### NEW – 2020 COVID-19 PROCEDURES

**Only individuals who have a signed Gardener Agreement on file with SMLC Staff will be permitted within the SMLC Community Organic Garden.**

- Gardeners will, when possible, provide and use their own tools.
- If a gardener is unable to supply their own tools, they can request from the Garden Coordinator to check out an SMLC tool for the season. Gardeners will disinfect any SMLC tools before use and when they return tool at the end of the season.
- Gardeners will disinfect water pump, valves, hose and spray nozzles before and after use.
- Gardeners will whenever possible maintain 6' apart from anyone not in their household while on site.

- Gardeners will wear face masks they are within 6 feet of individuals from outside of their household. Gardeners must provide their own face masks.
- No more than 10 people are permitted in the garden area at any given time
- No organized events (clean-ups, social, or other) are permitted to take place in the Garden.
- Gardeners will be expected to self-screen regarding Covid-19 symptoms (as defined by the CDC), international travel, and possible exposure, using the form provided to me by SMLC. If Gardeners are positive for symptoms, travel, or exposure, they should immediately notify Stewardship and Outreach Manager, Julie McLaughlin.
- Gardeners may not enter Garden if they have symptoms of Covid-19, have traveled internationally within the last 14 days, or have been in close contact with an individual who has tested positive for Covid-19 within the last 14 days.
