### The Preserve Loop Trail

The trail system is approximately **1.25 miles** in total length. The trail begins in a prairie restoration area. More than 15 acres of shrubs and trees were cut down in 2015 to expand the existing globally rare lakeplain prairie. The trail then follows along a prairie remnant that showcases what southeast Michigan looked like more than 200 years ago. As the trail continues north, the surrounding landscape transitions into an upland and lowland hardwood forest.

### Things you will see on the trail...

#### In the Prairie:

- Blazing Star
- Big Bluestem
- Colic Root

#### In the Forest:

- White Oak
- Red Maple
- May Apple
